Professor Christie S. Warren is Professor of the Practice of International and Comparative Law at William and Mary Law School, where she teaches Comparative Law, Comparative Constitutional Systems, Islamic Law, International Human Rights Law, and Post-Conflict Justice and the Rule of Law. She also serves as the Founding Director of William and Mary's Program in Comparative Legal Studies and Post-Conflict Justice. Professor Warren recently completed a year-long appointment as Senior Expert in Constitutional Issues for the United Nations Department of Political Affairs Mediation Support Unit and serves as the Curriculum Advisor for the Constitution-Building Processes Programme at International IDEA in Stockholm. She has worked in more than 35 post-conflict and developing countries around the world and served as an advisor to the Constitutional Commission of Kosovo during the 2007 - 8 constitution drafting process. She was named the 1998 – 1999 Supreme Court Fellow at the Supreme Court of the United States.
